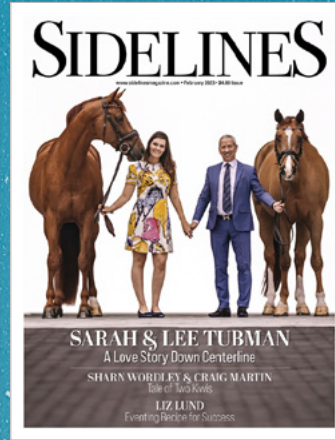
We will be using ShowGroundsLive for our shows and as always we try to communicate regularly and effectively.

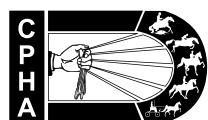

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

ENTRY CLOSING: Entries may be submitted electronically, mail, or hand delivered. Closing date for each show is ten days before the first day of competition. Late entries will be accepted.

STALL RESERVATIONS are due with entries

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- a) Entries will be accepted on a first come first reserved basis. Should stalls sell out a waiting list will be established.
- b) **Registration Fee**—All horses, showing or non-showing will be assessed the Registration Fee. This fee includes schooling in the show arenas when they are open. See Show Fees for the complete list of fees.
- c) Payment of fees may be made with check, cash, or credit card. Credit cards will be charged a 5% handling fee.
- d) **LATE ENTRIES** - Entries are due ten days before the first competition day. Entries received after this date will be charged a \$50 Late Fee.
- e) USEF, USHJA, PCHA, CPHA, LAHJA and other organizations have specific requirements for entry and participation in certain or all classes at this competition. It is the responsibility of exhibitors and trainers to know the rules, especially regarding eligibility. Stewards will be in attendance to provide assistance with these matters.
- f) **MICROCHIP VERIFICATION:** All horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration (Outreach excepted) must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered. A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen-digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal. All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions.
- g) **SAFE SPORT VERIFICATION:** As of January 1, 2019 all USEF members 18-years-old and older, with a Competing Membership, must complete SafeSport Training in order to be eligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions. Those who do not complete the training will be ineligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions. Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are bound by the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies, also known as the MAAPP. This includes the SafeSport Training requirement for adult members and participants who have regular contact with minor athletes. Additionally, please be reminded about reporting obligations. Any concerns that are non-sexual in nature, please use the USEF Safe Sport Incident Reporting Form available on the USEF website. Concerns or suspicions regarding sexual misconduct must be reported to <https://safesport.isight.com/portal> and the authorities if a minor is involved. All of this information can be found in the USEF Safe Sport Policy. To find the most up to date information, see the new USEF Safe Sport web pages on the USEF website including comprehensive resources regarding USEF Safe Sport efforts. You can also contact Sarah Gilbert, USEF Safe Sport Program Coordinator, at sgilbert@usef.org for any questions or concerns relating to the USEF Safe Sport program.

1. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: Horse arrival is anytime after 8:00am on Thursday. Departure is anytime before 8:00pm on Sunday. Early arrivals and/or late departures must be arranged in advance by emailing show@goldcoasthorseshow.com. Trainers may set up stalls and tack rooms on Wednesday after 12:00 p.m. provided trainer notifies the show via the email listed above.

2. STABLING: a stall is required for any horse not regularly boarded at HDHP, or any horse trailered to HDHP on a daily basis or ridden onto the facility. Stalls may not be shared or resold. First bedding is not included. Management reserves the right to limit tack stalls. Stall fees are not refundable after entry closing date unless all stalls are fully sold and the cancelled stall can be re-sold by show management to another competitor based on the show's waiting list. The show office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Stalls are wood construction (10'x10') and canvas (9'6"x9'6" and 12'x9'6") all with canvas roofs. All stalls have dirt floors and doors. If stall doors are removed, the person assigned to that stall (horse or other use) will be charged \$150 per stall door. Stall Fees are as follows:

Hunter/Jumper - \$190

Friday Hunter/Jumper - \$75 (available Thursday and move out Friday)

3. GROUNDS FEE: This fee is charged to entries that do not reserve show stalls. The fee is \$25 per day, including non-showing days for horses trailering in or ridden onto the grounds. Horses boarded at HDHP will pay a separate fee. To be considered an HDHP boarder, HDHP must have a boarding agreement on file.

4. NON-SHOWING HORSES: Any horse on the show grounds but not competing must be registered as a Non-Showing Horse. This includes completing and signing an entry blank, along with paying the requisite fee(s). Non-showing horses must pay the registration fee, a stall fee or grounds fee (as appropriate), and the drug fee. Trainers and riders of boarded horses at HDHP not entered in the show and wishing to ride and school in the show area will be treated as non-showing horses. All non-showing horses will be assigned a number. Late fees will apply.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 5. FEED AND BEDDING:** Feed and bedding are available for purchase during the horse show. If you want a delivery available upon your arrival, please make sure to complete the Pre-Show Feed and Bedding order form at: www.goldcoasthorseshow.com. Please note all deadlines and provide all required information in order to ensure your delivery. Same day orders are not available, and there are no Sunday deliveries. During the show, all orders must be placed by noon to ensure availability and delivery the next day. Exhibitors may bring their own feed/shavings, however deliveries from outside feed companies will not be allowed.
- 6. UNPAID ACCOUNTS:** All accounts not settled by 5:00pm on the last day of competition of the competition week will be closed out by the show secretary using the payment information provided. Entries with no method of payment will be charged a \$25 billing fee.
- 7. NUMBERS:** Horse entry numbers will not be released without form of payment and having all necessary paperwork completed. All horses on the grounds will be assigned a number, including non-showing horses. Whenever horses are being ridden, they must have their number displayed. This includes schooling sessions.
- 8. USEF RULE GR901.11:** All returned checks and declined credit cards will be charged a 10% penalty (\$50 minimum). Account holders will be given ten (10) days to be paid in full with cash, cash equivalent or credit card. After 10 days without payment the horse show will notify USEF and other sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.
- 9. MINOR EXHIBITORS:** No minor's entry will be accepted unless the entry blank is signed by a parent or guardian.
- 10. SPECIAL CLASSES:** Specifications are listed under Special Classes. Classes with prize money must have at least five entries, otherwise the class will be held without prize money and the entry fee lowered to the Regular class price. See Special Class information in Division Specifications.
- 11. ADDING REGULAR CLASSES:** There is no additional (post entry) fee to add regular classes. Adds must be done by 4:00pm the day preceding the class in order to guarantee entry. Same day adds may be restricted and must be done in the Horse Show Office before the class starts.
- 12. SCRATCHING REGULAR CLASSES:** Classes (with the exception of classics and special classes) scratched prior to the start of the class will receive full credit.
- 13. SHOW SCRATCH:** A "Show Scratch" is applied to any horse entered in the show that does not show in any classes and is not registered as a "Nonshowing Horse." In order to be eligible for a refund, Show Scratches must be submitted in writing (email okay) by the deadlines described herein. Show Scratches submitted before the official closing date for the show entered will receive a full refund of the stall fee, the registration fee, and any other fees paid (except credit card fee). Show Scratches submitted after the closing date and before the start of the show will receive a refund of the stall fee and a 50% refund of the registration fee, plus any other fees paid (except credit card fee). Show Scratches submitted after the show begins will receive a refund of any classes not shown in.
- 14. SUBSTITUTIONS:** Under the same ownership (or lease), a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse as long as the scratched horse has not shown in any classes. The scratched horse's registration Fee and stall fee are transferred to the substituted horse with no penalty.
- 15. CONFLICTS:** It is the intention of management to avoid holding rings to wait for horses and/or riders. Trainers and riders anticipating a conflict are responsible to contacting the starters of the affected arena(s) and show manager(s). Ultimately, riders and trainers are responsible for minimizing conflicts and the show staff will do their best to address conflicts and keep the show running on schedule. Starters have the authority from management to scratch riders who are not timely. Trainer availability is not considered a legitimate conflict.
- 16. MINIMUM ENTRIES:** Medal classes and special classes that do not have enough entries to fill by 4:00 p.m. the preceding day will be combined if possible, and otherwise cancelled. Management may elect to run regular classes with one entry. For Special Classes—see section on Special classes.
- 17. RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter):** Entries that show in a class that are not properly entered will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$25.00 RDNE Fee per class.
- 18. PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money checks will be applied to the entry account, and any balance will be mailed to the listed payee within 30 days of the conclusion of the show. Tax ID of PAYEE is required before any prize money will be sent. Exhibitors are responsible for listing the correct payee information. Please confirm with the show secretary that the prize money payee is correct. Prize money payouts are detailed in the Special Classes section.
- 19. SCHOOLING & TICKET ROUNDS:** Schooling will be permitted in designated areas only. The word schooling includes, but is not limited to riding, driving, lunging, leading, and exercising. Poling and/or the use of offsets WILL NOT be permitted anywhere at Hansen Dam Horse Park. Violations of schooling regulations may be considered cause for fines and/or elimination. Horses must display their

official horse show number and riders must be properly attired. Management reserves the right to open competition arenas for limited schooling at the end of each day's competition. Management reserves the right to implement paid ticket rounds.

20. SCHOOLING SUPERVISION: Please be advised that starters have authority as agents of management to enforce USEF schooling rules.

21. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Per USEF GR801.2 All persons required by USEF rules to wear protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag must do so while mounted anywhere on the competition grounds. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition.

SAFETY VESTS: Any exhibitor may wear a protective vest either body protecting or inflatable, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest pass or surpass the current ASTM standard F1937 or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute.

22. DAMAGE / HOLES IN STALLS & BARN WALLS: Damage to stalls (permanent or portable) will be billed to the account of the owner of the horse occupying the stall, or in the case of tack stalls to the trainer assigned the stalls. All stalls will be checked by the barn manager prior to move in of the horses. Please note any prior damage to stalls to the barn manager immediately upon occupancy to avoid any incorrect charges.

23. ARENAS: The arenas are of the sizes and footing types as listed below.

14. MOTORIZED VEHICLES / GOLF CARTS: At all times drivers are expected to drive only in designated areas, at safe speeds, and with an eye toward safety. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

25. PERSONAL ELECTRONIC TRANSPORT DEVICES: GR1301.8 The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials or management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people or horses gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

26. DOGS: All dogs must be on leashes or otherwise contained. Owners of loose dogs will be subject to a minimum fine of \$100 and the issuance of a USEF Official Warning Card.

27. DESIGNATED PARKING: All horse show related drivers, except HDHP boarders and trainers are required to enter the facility through the Horse Show Entrance Gate, which is the second gate past the HDHP Main Gate. All vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. Improperly parked vehicles are subject to tow at the owner's expense. Parking in the stable area is a safety hazard and not allowed except for immediate loading and unloading. Vehicles displaying a state issued disability parking permit may park in designated

spaces.

28. MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a \$100 fine per occurrence.

29. VACCINATIONS and HEALTH CERTIFICATES:

- a. Per USEF GR844 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation licensed competitions, horses more than 7 months of age entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horse not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.
- b. A Declaration of Health (from trainer or owner) or a Statement of Health/Veterinary Health Certificate (from a licensed veterinarian) may be required. Please check with management for requirement details.

30. RV PARKING: A limited number of RV spaces with water and electric are available. Please complete and submit the official RV reservation form available at: www.goldcoasthorseshow.com. Spaces are provided on a first reserved basis. Hook ups are provided for water and electric service. High amp RVs may have restricted electric use. Pump out service is extra and must be scheduled through the horse show office. Please give 24 hour notice for pump out scheduling.

31. CRUELTY AND ABUSE: Abuse includes, but is not limited to excessive use of spurs or whip, or use of the whip anywhere in front of the horse's shoulder. Per USEF GR838 Any action(s) against a horse by a competitor which are deemed excessive by a judge, Federation steward, technical delegate, or competition veterinarian in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning or elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee, or Competition Management in the absence of a Show Committee. Cruelty and Abuse will not be tolerated at any time, anywhere at Hansen Dam Horse Park.

33. MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions with regard to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, alter any course, cancel, combine, or re-schedule classes, change rings, substitute judges, change specifications in jumper classes, etc. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Management whose decision will be final.

32. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Per city of Los Angeles regulations, alcoholic beverages are not permitted

33. NO SMOKING: Per city of Los Angeles regulations, smoking is not permitted.

34. COOKING & BARBECUES: For fire safety, no cooking or barbecues are allowed at Hansen Dam Horse Park except in the RV area, or another location approved by show management. Only gas or propane barbecues are allowed. Please, no charcoal generated fires.

35. SHOW PASS FEES: For those hunter/jumper exhibitors who are not current members of the USHJA a \$30 Show Pass will be added to your entry. Riders and Owners will only be allowed ONE USEF Show Pass per calendar year. The show pass must be paid from your USEF account on your member dashboard. Anyone listed as a Trainer or Coach (including Parents) must be active USEF members. In addition each horse, regardless of whether the owner is a current member of the USEF or USHJA must pay a \$75 lifetime horse registration fee.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division, 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes, and 12) USEF Lite competitions.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND DEFINITIONS OF THE RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION.

In consideration for entry upon the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES of the COMPETITION, the undersigned on behalf of myself, my trainers, instructors, coaches, clients, agents, employees, grooms, invitees, representatives, assigns, executors, heirs, independent contractors (including but not limited to veterinarians, farriers, masseuse, chiropractor, therapists, braiders, shippers), and, if applicable, on behalf of my minor child or children (hereinafter collectively referred to as "I") agrees:

I agree that COMPETITION as used in this entry blank, in the prize list and in the USEF rules means the Gold Coast Horse Shows (individually and as a whole), each and every class and/or event conducted and ALL ACTIVITIES that I undertake AT ANY TIME upon entry of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES including any horse which is on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for my use, in my control or at my request. I further agree that COMPETITION includes the entire week of the horse show including the time horses and/or people are allowed to enter to set up, stable and/or conduct business whether its expressly and/or specifically related to the horse show and classes being conducted/held that week through and including the time all horses and/or people vacate the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES.

I agree that this Release of Liability includes any horse that I have asked to come onto the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for any purpose, and/or is in my control and/or custody and regardless whether the horse is being stabled at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or competing in the COMPETITION. I agree that "RELEASED PARTIES" means the competition known as Gold Coast Horse Shows (individually and as a whole), the "Horse Show Management" as referenced in the prize list, Langer Equestrian Group, Inc. and each of their officers, directors, managers, members, owners, shareholders, employees, representatives, agents, subsidiaries, volunteers, officials, affiliated and associated persons, companies and organizations, assigns and entities or organizations related to Horse Show Management and/or related to or manage the property owned by such entities.

I agree that SHOW GROUND FACILITIES means the Hansen Dam Horse Park including but not limited to all improvements, structures (permanent or temporary), buildings, tents, stalls, fixtures (including but not limited to all jumps and related equipment), arenas, exercise and schooling areas (and the footing therein) located on the premises and/or provided by RELEASED PARTIES during the COMPETITION.

I agree that if I am not a member of USEF that I will abide by all rules and regulations of USEF. I agree that the Rules of the Prize List are incorporated as if set forth herein.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS: I hereby fully and forever release, waive and discharge the RELEASED PARTIES and each of them who are or might be liable in any way from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of actions, liabilities of any kind which I may or might have against RELEASED PARTIES or any of them, arising from or by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, damage to property, injury to horse and any consequences thereof, which I may sustain due to the ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES; I further agree that except for the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the RELEASED PARTIES, I shall not bring any legal action, claim, demand against and/or sue for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage and/or injury to any horse in relation to the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or the operation and conduct of the COMPETITION. I agree this RELEASE INCLUDES ALL ACTIVITIES I PARTICIPATE IN AND ALL AREAS OF THE SHOW GROUND FACILITIES as defined above.

HOLD HARMLESS: I hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless RELEASED PARTIES from and against any and all claims, liabilities, loss, damages, demands, actions, causes of action, including attorneys' fees, cost and expenses of any kind, which may be made against them, or any of them, by anyone, which arise out of my actions, including my ordinary negligence, including active and passive, and gross negligence or willful misconduct and/or the active or passive negligence of RELEASED PARTIES while either I or any horse at my request or in my control is/was on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or participating in the COMPETITION.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I hereby acknowledge and assume the risk that equestrian activity, including jumping, is very dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I expressly acknowledge that injuries may be compounded or increased by negligent maintenance of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES, faulty or improperly secured equipment, improper supervision or compliance with USEF rules and regulations, Acts of God and negligent rescue operations or procedures of RELEASED PARTIES and negligent handling of horses and independent operations by trainers, riders and/or boarders who use the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES or others who are not affiliated with RELEASED PARTIES. I acknowledge that horses can be injured while being ridden, groomed, stabled, walked and/or exercised and I expressly assume the risk of injury to any horse under my control and/or custody or on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES at my request.

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California with respect to all RELEASED PARTIES, except for the USEF as set forth on page one. I agree this Release extends to all acts of ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law. If any portion of this Release and/or Entry Blank is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect. I have not relied on any oral representations or statements made that are contrary to or modify the above Release or warnings. I agree that by signing the front page of this Entry Blank that I am bound by the Release, waiver and warnings contained herein and that both sides/pages constitute one incorporated agreement. If applicable, I agree I have the express authority to sign this entry blank/Release on behalf of the owner and/or rider. Federation Entry Agreement: By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultier or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Gold Coast Horse Shows.

I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

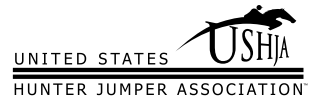

In accordance with GR1111.4: All members may compete for Zone Awards or money in any state contiguous to Zone 10: OR, ID, UT, AZ

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS: To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION: To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION: To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Sections offered and requirements: Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections. **Cross Entry: Riders:** Riders may not cross enter into any Green Hunter 3'6", Green Hunter 3'9" or High Performance Hunter class at the same competition. Exception - under saddle classes. Adult Amateur Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same competition with fences exceeding 3'3" except Jumper Classes not exceeding 1.25m, Equitation and Medal Classes, and the USHJA National Hunter Derby. Riders may cross enter between the Adult Amateur Hunter and the Amateur Owner section if the rider owns the horse he or she is showing in the Adult Amateur section. An Adult Amateur rider may ride an Amateur Owner Hunter in the A/O Under Saddle Class for an Amateur Owner Hunter rider that has more than one horse entered. No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. **Horses:** Horses may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner hunter class (at the same show). No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. **Fence Height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. In and outs are permitted. **Classics:** Three (3) entries are required to conduct a Hunter Classic. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** May be split into three (3) sections: Adult Amateurs 18– 35, Adult Amateurs 36–49, Adult Amateurs 50 & Over. If there are fewer than three (3) entries, the Adult Amateur Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Horse section. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Adult Amateur Hunter 18–35, Adult Amateur 36–49, Adult Amateurs 50 & Over.

LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. **Cross Entry: Riders:** Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 3'0" Fence Height: 2'6" **Combining/Dividing Sections:** If there are fewer than three (3) entries in the Low Adult Amateur Hunter section, it may be combined with the Low Children's Hunter Horse section. The Low Adult Amateur Hunter Horse section may only be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony and Low Children's Hunter Horse sections after those sections have been combined and still do not meet the three (3) entry minimum. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: Low Adult Amateur Hunter.

AMATEUR JUMPER: Sections offered and requirements: 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper, 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper. **Cross Entry:** No cross entry restrictions at one day competitions. **Rider:** 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.15m. 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.25m. **Horse/Pony:** n/a. **Horse and Rider Combination:** n/a. **Fence Height:** Amateur Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m. Amateur Jumper 1.10m for the first class of the section. In all other classes of the section fences to be set no lower than 1.10m and no higher than 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** 1.00/1.05m Junior's and 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper sections must combine if there are fewer than three (3) in either section and may combine if there are fewer than six (6) in either section. If after combining the 1.00/1.05m sections there are fewer than three (3) entries then competition management must further combine the 1.00/1.05m sections with the 1.10/1.15m sections, allowing each section to compete at their respective height. 1.10/1.15m Junior's and 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper sections must combine if there are fewer than three (3) in either section and may combine if there are fewer than six (6) in either section. If after combining the 1.10/1.15m sections there are fewer than three (3) entries then competition management must further combine the 1.10/1.15m sections with the 1.00/1.05m sections, allowing each section to compete at their respective height. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper, 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper.

AGE GROUP EQUITATION: ADULT SECTION Refer to GR1131. **Fence Height:** Fence heights cannot exceed 3'5" and wings are optional. To be shown over a course of not fewer than eight fences. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** If the adult equitation does not fill it must be combined with a junior or child section. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Equitation 18- 35, Equitation 36 and Over.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE Sections offered and requirements: Children's Hunter Horse. **Cross Entry: Rider:** Riders may not cross enter into any Junior Hunter, Green Hunter 3'6", Green Hunter 3'9" or High Performance Hunter class at the same show. Exception - under saddle classes. Children's riders may not cross enter into any class at the same competition with fences exceeding 3'3" (exception:

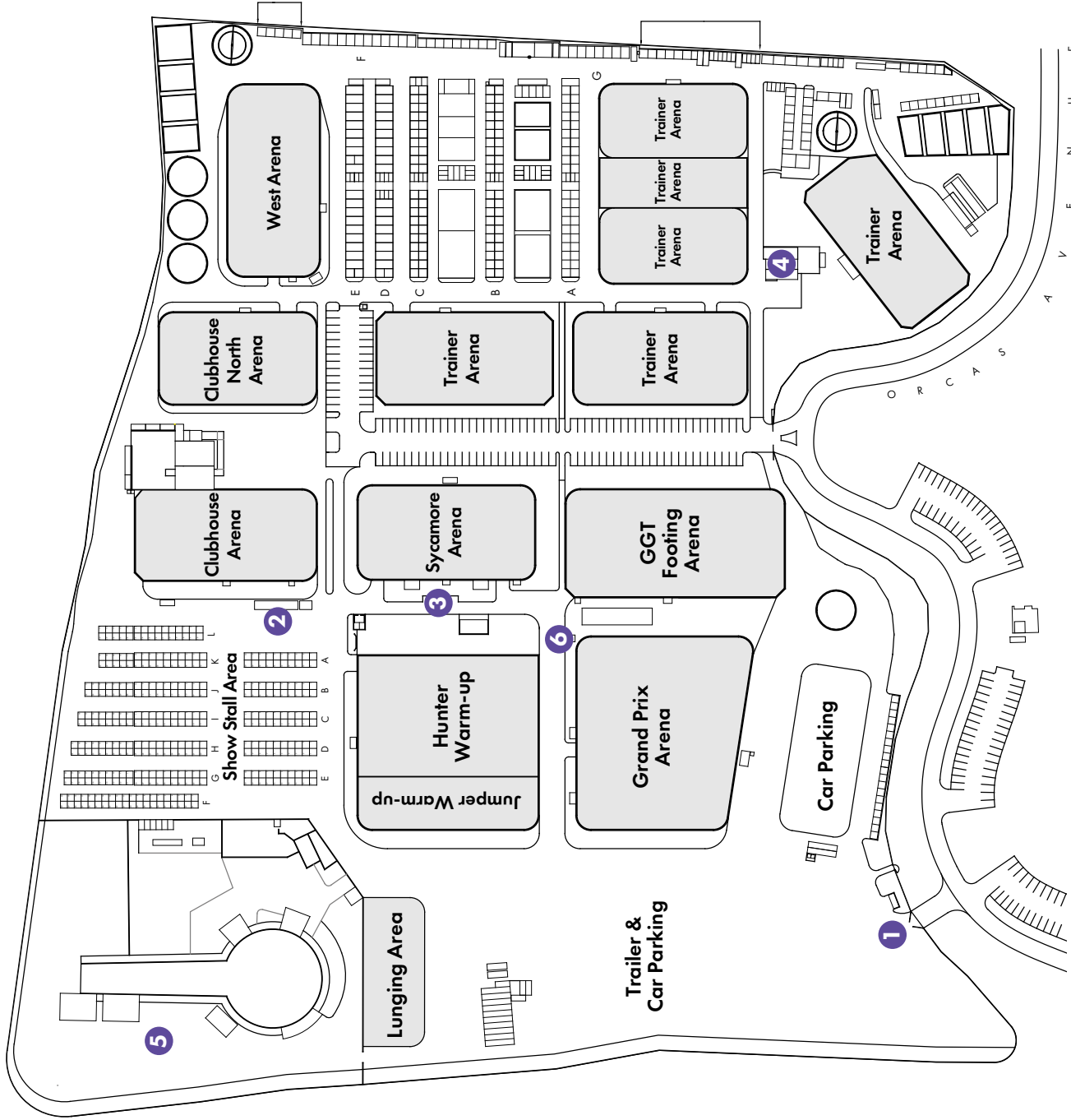

No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. **Horses/Ponies:** Horses may not cross enter into any 3'6" Junior Hunter Class at the same competition. No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. **Horse and rider combination:** No cross entry restrictions at one-day competitions. Classics: Three (3) entries are required to conduct a Hunter Classic. Fence Height: 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height. In and outs are permitted. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** If there are fewer than three (3) entries, the Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Adult Amateur Hunter section. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Children's Hunter Horse.

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. **Cross Entry: Riders:** Riders may not cross enter at the same competition into any class/section where fences exceed 3'0" Fence Height: 2'6" **Combining/Dividing Sections:** If there are fewer than three (3) horses entered in the Low Children's Hunter Horse section, then they may be combined and judged with the Children's Hunter Ponies or the Low Adult Amateur Hunter section. If there are still fewer than three (3) entries after the Children's Hunter Pony section has been combined with the Low Children's Hunter Horse section, these sections may only then combine with the Low Adult Amateur Hunter Horse section. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: Low Children's Hunter Horse.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY Sections offered and requirements: Small/Medium Children's Pony, Large Children's Pony. **Cross Entry: Rider:** Rider may not cross enter in any division where the fences exceed 3'3" (exception: Children's Jumper sections). **Horse/Pony:** n/a. **Horse and Rider Combination:** n/a. **Fence Height:** Small/Medium Ponies: 2'0"; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Large Ponies: 2'6"; spreads not to exceed height of fence. In and outs are not permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** If there are fewer than three (3) ponies in the Children's Hunter Small/Medium Pony or Children's Hunter Large Pony, then the classes may be combined and judged together. If there are still fewer than three (3) ponies after the Small/Medium and Large sections have been combined, the Children's Hunter Pony sections may combine with the Low Children's Hunter Horse section. If there are still fewer than three (3) entries after the Children's Hunter Small/Medium and Large Pony sections have been combined with the Low Children's Hunter Horse section, these sections may only then combine with the Low Adult Amateur Hunter Horse section. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Children's Hunter Pony.

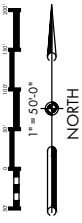
JUNIOR JUMPER Sections offered and Requirements: 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper, 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper. **Cross Entry:** No cross entry restrictions at one day competitions. **Rider:** 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.15m. 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper riders may not cross enter into any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.25m. **Horse/Pony:** n/a. **Horse and Rider Combination:** n/a. **Fence Height:** Junior Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m. Junior Jumper 1.10m for the first class of the section. In all other classes of the section fences to be set no lower than 1.10m and no higher than 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** 1.00/1.05m Junior and 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper sections must combine if there are fewer than three (3) in either section and may combine if there are fewer than six (6) in either section. AGE GROUP EQUITATION: CHILDREN'S/JUNIOR SECTION Refer to GR1131. **Fence Height: Equitation 11 & Under:** Minimum 2'6", maximum 2'9" - management must state height at which class will be offered. Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Combinations not permitted. **Equitation 12-14:** Minimum 2'9", maximum 3'3" - management must state height at which class will be offered. Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Combinations are optional. **Equitation 15-17:** Minimum 3'0", maximum 3'5" - management must state height at which class will be offered. Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Combinations are optional. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Competition management may offer Age Group Equitation classes divided at their discretion. Equitation that is offered by age will be awarded points that will be credited to the age groups defined in GR1131 or the relevant Zone Specifications. If the Equitation 11 & Under section is combined with the Equitation 12-14 section, the combined section will be run in accordance with the Equitation 12-14 specifications with optional combinations. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Equitation 11 & Under, Equitation 12-14, Equitation 15-17.
