Gold Coast Series points are counted through October, and then be sure to get your tickets for the Gold Coast Gala on Saturday evening of the Finale.





### **WESTERN DIVISIONS**

Reining classes will be judged under CRHA and NRHA rules. All other classes will be judged under PCHA rules.

Riders are expected to be properly attired and horses are expected to have proper tack and equipment based on the rules of the associations listed above. Banding and tail extensions are discouraged.

Prize money will be paid through third to the owner of the horse: 50%, 30%, 20%, unless stated otherwise. Prize money will be applied to entries unless a check is specifically requested. Any additional amount owed will be mailed to the owner of record within 30 days.

High score awards will be presented as designated below. Points will be calculated 1st-6, 2nd-4, 3rd-3, 4th-2, and 5th-1. Ties will be broken by most first places. If still tied, the points earned on Sunday will break the tie.

### \$2,500 GOLD COAST RANCH HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

### at the Gold Coast Finale

We are inviting all Ranch Riding enthusiasts to our Gold Coast Finale and the first annual Gold Coast Ranch Horse Championships. We have a \$2,500 Open section and a Walk/Jog section with great ribbons and prizes, along with \$2,500 of prize money in the open championship.

### \$2,500 GOLD COAST RANCH HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

Entry fee: \$160

The \$2,500 Gold Coast Ranch Horse Championship is a three-phase competition open to all horses and riders, with no qualification required:

- Ranch Rail
- Ranch Riding (pattern)
- Ranch Trail

Each class will be judged separately with an award to first, ribbons through fifth, and prize money paid through third. Scores from each class for each horse will be converted to points based on the percentages below. The Ranch Horses with the highest number of points will determine the top three overall Gold Coast Ranch Horses. If there is a tie, the trail score will serve as the tie breaker. Overall scoring is as follows:

- Ranch Rail 30% of score earned.
- Ranch Riding (pattern) 30% of score
- Ranch Trail 40% of score

Example: If a horse receives a score of 75 in the rail class, 30% equals 22.50 points. A score of 72 in the Pattern class equals 21.60 points, and a score of 70 in trail equals 28 points. This would give the horse a total of 72.10 overall points.

### Prize money will be paid as follows:

\$1,000 will be distributed in the individual classes as follows:

- \$300 Ranch Rail
- \$300 Ranch Riding
- \$400 Ranch Trail

Prize money will be paid through third: 50%-30%-20%. \$1,500 will be paid to the overall top five as follows: 30%-25%-20%-15%-10%

If there are fewer than ten entries in the Championship, prize money will be reduced to \$1,500 with \$750 split among the three classes and \$750 paid out to the top five. The adjustment to the individual classes will be \$250 to each of three classes. The entry fee will be adjusted to \$130.

### There will be special prizes for:

- High Score First/Second Year Horse
- High Score First/Second Year Rider
- High Score Youth/Amateur Rider

For purposes of this Championship, First/Second Year is defined as not having competed in any Ranch Classes prior to 2023.

### GOLD COAST WALK/JOG RANCH HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

The Gold Coast Walk/Jog Ranch Horse Championship is open to riders who have not competed in classes requiring loping in the past two years. This Championship will be run under the same format with special ribbons and awards presented in the individual classes, as well as the top three overall. Horses must be ridden by the same rider throughout each competition. A horse may compete in both championships with a different rider in each of the two championships.

For any questions on the specifications or conduct of the class, the decision of Ranch Rider Championship Show Committee will be final. This committee will be made up of: Show Manager, Show Secretary, and one of the judges.

### **EARTH RIDER ENVIRONMENT FEE**

You will see a \$10 fee on your entry per horse. This fee helps support our work to be good stewards of our land, resources, and to treat our communal environment with respect. We have partnered with EarthRiders.org to implement a variety of actions to fulfill our goal of using our resources wisely and to be a mindful steward of our land.

You can do your part. "Nothing but rain down the drain!" Scoop your horse's poop in the wash rack rather than washing it down the drain. Look for the EarthRiders buckets and shovels.

Keep your barn areas free of manure and look for HDHP staff working to keep our common areas clear of manure. Please ask your grooms to throw trash in the trash barrels and keep used manure and bedding free from pollutants.

Thanks for being an EarthRider and keeping horses and horse activities within our urban areas.

### **RIBBON BUY BACK**

If you aren't taking your ribbons home, bring them back to the horse show office. As long as the ribbons are clean and unmarked, we will give you a \$1 credit per ribbon on your entry fees. This is another of our EarthRider initiatives where we live by the Three Rs: Repurpose, Reuse, and Recycle!

**ENTRY CLOSING:** Entries may be submitted electronically, mail, or hand delivered. Closing date for each show is ten days before the first day of competition. Late entries will be accepted.

### **STALL RESERVATIONS** are due with entries

### **ENTRY PROCEDURES**

- a) Entries will be accepted on a first come first reserved basis. Should stalls sell out a waiting list will be established.
- **b) Registration Fee**—All horses, showing or non-showing will be assessed the Registration Fee. This fee includes schooling in the show arenas when they are open. See Show Fees for the complete list of fees.
- c) Payment of fees may be made with check, cash, or credit card. Credit cards will be charged a 3.5% handling fee.
- d) LATE ENTRIES Entries are due ten days before the first competition day. Entries received after this date will be charged a \$35 Late Fee.
- e) PCHA, CRHA and other organizations have specific requirements for entry and participation in certain or all classes at this competition. It is the responsibility of exhibitors and trainers to know the rules, especially regarding eligibility. Stewards and management can provide assistance with these matters.
- **1. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** Horse arrival is anytime after 8:00am on Thursday. Departure is anytime before 8:00pm on Sunday. Early arrivals and/or late departures must be arranged in advance by emailing show@goldcoasthorseshows.com. Trainers may set up stalls and tack rooms on Wednesday after 12:00 p.m. provided trainer notifies the show via the email listed above.
- 2. STABLING: a stall is required for any horse not regularly boarded at HDHP, or any horse trailered to HDHP on a daily basis or ridden onto the facility. Stalls may not be shared or resold. First bedding is not included. Management reserves the right to limit tack stalls. Stall fees are not refundable after entry closing date unless all stalls are fully sold and the cancelled stall can be re-sold by show management to another competitor based on the show's waiting list. The show office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Stalls are wood construction (10'x10') and canvas (9'6"x9'6" and 12'x9'6") all with canvas roofs. All stalls have dirt floors and doors. If stall doors are removed, the person assigned to that stall (horse or other use) will be charged \$150 per stall door. Stall Fees are as detailed on the Show Fees page.
- **3. GROUNDS FEE:** This fee is charged to entries that do not reserve show stalls. The fee is due for non-showing and showing days for horses trailering in or ridden onto the grounds. Horses boarded at HDHP will pay a separate fee. To be considered an HDHP boarder, HDHP must have a boarding agreement on file. See Show Fees.
- **4. NON-SHOWING HORSES:** Any horse on the show grounds but not competing must be registered as a Non-Showing Horse. This includes completing and signing an entry blank, along with paying the requisite fee(s). Non-showing horses must pay the registration fee, a stall fee or grounds fee (as appropriate), and the drug fee. Trainers and riders of boarded horses at HDHP not entered in the show and wishing to ride and school in the show area will be treated as non-showing horses. All non-showing horses will be assigned a number. Late fees will apply.
- **5. FEED AND BEDDING:** Feed and bedding are available for purchase during the horse show. If you want a delivery available upon your arrival, please make sure to complete the Pre-Show Feed and Bedding order form at: www. goldcoasthorseshows.com. Please note all deadlines and provide all required information in order to ensure your delivery. Same day orders are not available, and there are no Sunday deliveries. During the show, all orders must be placed by noon to ensure availability and delivery the next day. Exhibitors may bring their own feed/shavings, however deliveries from outside feed companies will not be allowed.
- **6. UNPAID ACCOUNTS:** All accounts not settled by 5:00pm on the last day of competition of the competition week will be closed out by the show secretary using the payment information provided. Entries with no method of payment will be charged a \$25 billing fee.
- **7. NUMBERS:** Horse entry numbers will not be released without form of payment and having all necessary paperwork completed. All horses on the grounds will be assigned a number, including non-showing horses. Whenever horses are being

ridden, they must have their number displayed. This includes schooling sessions.

- **8. NON-PAYMENT:** All returned checks and declined credit cards will be charged a 10% penalty (\$50 minimum). Account holders will be given ten (10) days to be paid in full with cash, cash equivalent or credit card. After 10 days without payment the horse show will notify sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.
- 9. MINOR EXHIBITORS: No minor's entry will be accepted unless the entry blank is signed by a parent or quardian.
- **10. SPECIAL CLASSES**: Specifications are listed under Special Classes. Classes with prize money must have at least five entries, otherwise the class will be held without prize money and the entry fee lowered to the Regular class price. See Special Class information in Division Specifications.
- **11. ADDING REGULAR CLASSES:** There is no additional (post entry) fee to add regular classes. Adds must be done by 4:00pm the day preceding the class in order to guarantee entry. Same day adds may be restricted and must be done in the Horse Show Office before the class starts.
- 12. SCRATCHING REGULAR CLASSES: Classes (with the exception of classics and special classes) scratched prior to the start of the class will receive full credit.
- 13. SHOW SCRATCH: A "Show Scratch" is applied to any horse entered in the show that does not show in any classes and is not registered as a "Nonshowing Horse." In order to be eligible for a refund, Show Scratches must be submitted in writing (email okay) by the deadlines described herein. Show Scratches submitted before the official closing date for the show entered will receive a full refund of the stall fee, the registration fee, and any other fees paid (except credit card fee). Show Scratches submitted after the closing date and before the start of the show will receive a refund of the stall fee and a 50% refund of the registration fee, plus any other fees paid (except credit card fee). Show Scratches submitted after the show begins will receive a refund of any classes not shown in.
- **14. SUBSTITUTIONS:** Under the same ownership (or lease), a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse as long as the scratched horse has not shown in any classes. The scratched horse's registration Fee and stall fee are transferred to the substituted horse with no penalty.
- **15. CONFLICTS:** It is the intention of management to avoid holding rings to wait for horses and/or riders. Trainers and riders anticipating a conflict are responsible to contacting the starters of the affected arena(s) and show manager(s). Ultimately, riders and trainers are responsible for minimizing conflicts and the show staff will do their best to address conflicts and keep the show running on schedule. Starters have the authority from management to scratch riders who are not timely. Trainer availability is not considered a legitimate conflict.
- **16. MINIMUM ENTRIES:** Medal classes and special classes that do not have enough entries to fill by 4:00 p.m. the preceding day will be combined if possible, and otherwise cancelled. Management may elect to run regular classes with one entry. For Special Classes—see section on Special classes.
- **17. RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter)**: Entries that show in a class that are not properly entered will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$25.00 RDNE Fee per class.
- **18. PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money checks will be applied to the entry account, and any balance will be mailed to the listed payee within 30 days of the conclusion of the show. Tax ID of PAYEE is required before any prize money will be sent. Exhibitors are responsible for listing the correct payee information. Please confirm with the show secretary that the prize money payee is correct. Prize money payouts are detailed in the Special Classes section.
- 19. SCHOOLING & TICKET ROUNDS: Schooling will be permitted in designated areas only. The word schooling includes, but is not limited to riding, driving, lunging, leading, and exercising. Poling and/or the use of offsets WILL NOT be permitted anywhere at Hansen Dam Horse Park. Violations of schooling regulations may be considered cause for fines and/or elimination. Horses must display their official horse show number and riders must be properly attired. Management reserves the right to open competition arenas for limited schooling at the end of each day's competition. Management reserves the right to implement paid ticket rounds.

- **20. SCHOOLING SUPERVISION:** Please be advised that announcers have authority as agents of management to enforce schooling rules.
- **21. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR**: Use of protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag is strongly encouraged. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition.

**SAFETY VESTS:** Any exhibitor may wear a protective vest either body protecting or inflatable, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest pass or surpass the current ASTM standard F1937 or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute.

- **22. DAMAGE / HOLES IN STALLS & BARN WALLS:** Damage to stalls (permanent or portable) will be billed to the account of the owner of the horse occupying the stall, or in the case of tack stalls to the trainer assigned the stalls. All stalls will be checked by the barn manager prior to move in of the horses. Please note any prior damage to stalls to the barn manager immediately upon occupancy to avoid any incorrect charges.
- 23. ARENAS: The arenas are of the sizes and footing types as listed below.

- 14. MOTORIZED VEHICLES / GOLF CARTS: At all times drivers are expected to drive only in designated areas, at safe speeds, and with an eye toward safety. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- **25. PERSONAL ELECTRONIC TRANSPORT DEVICES:** The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials or management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people or horses gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- **26. DOGS**: All dogs must be on leashes or otherwise contained. Owners of loose dogs will be subject to a minimum fine of \$100 and the issuance of a Horse Show Official Warning Card.
- **27. DESIGNATED PARKING:** All horse show related drivers, except HDHP boarders and trainers are required to enter the facility through the Horse Show Entrance Gate, which is the second gate past the HDHP Main Gate. All vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. Improperly parked vehicles are subject to tow at the owner's expense. Parking in the stable area is

a safety hazard and not allowed except for immediate loading and unloading. Vehicles displaying a state issued disability parking permit may park in designated spaces.

**28. MEDICAL WASTE:** Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a \$100 fine per occurrence.

### 29. VACCINATIONS and HEALTH CERTIFICATES:

- a. Horses more than 7 months of age entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horse not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.
- **b.** A Declaration of Health (from trainer or owner) or a Statement of Health/Veterinary Health Certificate (from a licensed veterinarian) may be required. Please check with management for requirement details.
- **30. RV PARKING:** A limited number of RV spaces with water and electric are available. Please complete and submit the official RV reservation form available at: www.goldcoasthorseshows.com. Spaces are provided on a first reserved basis. Hook ups are provided for water and electric service. High amp RVs may have restricted electric use. Pump out service is extra and must be scheduled through the horse show office. Please give 24 hour notice for pump out scheduling.
- **31. CRUELTY AND ABUSE:** Abuse includes, but is not limited to excessive use of spurs or whip, or use of the whip anywhere in front of the horse's shoulder. Any action(s) against a horse by a competitor which are deemed excessive by a judge, steward, technical delegate, or competition veterinarian in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning or elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee, or Competition Management in the absence of a Show Committee. Cruelty and Abuse will not be tolerated at any time, anywhere at Hansen Dam Horse Park.
- **33. MANAGEMENT:** The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions with regard to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, alter any course, cancel, combine, or re-schedule classes, change rings, substitute judges, change specifications in jumper classes, etc. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Management whose decision will be final.
- 32. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Per city of Los Angeles regulations, alcoholic beverages are not permitted
- **33. NO SMOKING:** Per city of Los Angeles regulations, smoking is not permitted.
- **34. COOKING & BARBECUES**: For fire safety, no cooking or barbecues are allowed at Hansen Dam Horse Park except in the RV area, or another location approved by show management. Only gas or propane barbecues are allowed. Please, no charcoal generated fires.

In consideration for entry upon the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES of the COMPETITION, the undersigned on behalf of myself, my trainers, instructors, coaches, clients, agents, employees, grooms, invitees, representatives, assigns, executors, heirs, independent contractors (including but not limited to veterinarians, farriers, masseuse, chiropractor, therapists, braiders, shippers), and, if applicable, on behalf of my minor child or children (hereinafter collectively referred to as "I") agrees:

I agree that COMPETITION as used in this entry blank, and in the prize list means the Gold Coast Horse Shows (individually and as a whole), each and every class and/or event conducted and ALL ACTIVITIES that I undertake AT ANY TIME upon entry of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES including any horse which is on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for my use, in my control or at my request. I further agree that COMPETITION includes the entire week of the horse show including the time horses and/or people are allowed to enter to set up, stable and/or conduct business whether its expressly and/or specifically related to the horse show and classes being conducted/held that week through and including the time all horses and/or people vacate the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES.

I agree that this Release of Liability includes any horse that I have asked to come onto the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for any purpose, and/or is in my control and/or custody and regardless whether the horse is being stabled at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or competing in the COMPETITION.

I agree that "RELEASED PARTIES" means the competition known as Gold Coast Horse Shows (individually and as a whole), the "Horse Show Management" as referenced in the prize list, Langer Equestrian Group, Inc. and each of their officers, directors, managers, members, owners, shareholders, employees, representatives, agents, subsidiaries, volunteers, officials, affiliated and associated persons, companies and organizations, assigns and entities or organizations related to Horse Show Management and/or related to or manage the property owned by such entities.

I agree that SHOW GROUND FACILITIES means the Hansen Dam Horse Park including but not limited to all improvements, structures (permanent or temporary), buildings, tents, stalls, fixtures (including but not limited to all jumps and related equipment), arenas, exercise and schooling areas (and the footing therein) located on the premises and/or provided by RELEASED PARTIES during the COMPETITION.


**RELEASE AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS**: I hereby fully and forever release, waive and discharge the RELEASED PARTIES and each of them who are or might be liable in any way from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of actions, liabilities of any kind which I may or might have against RELEASED PARTIES or any of them, arising from or by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, damage to property, injury to horse and any consequences thereof, which I may sustain due to the ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES; I further agree that except for the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the RELEASED PARTIES, I shall not bring any legal action, claim, demand against and/or sue for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage and/or injury to any horse in relation to the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or the operation and conduct of the COMPETITION. I agree this RELEASE INCLUDES ALL ACTIVITIES I PARTICIPATE IN AND ALL AREAS OF THE SHOW GROUND FACILITIES as defined above.

**HOLD HARMLESS**: I hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless RELEASED PARTIES from and against any and all claims, liabilities, loss, damages, demands, actions, causes of action, including attorneys' fees, cost and expenses of any kind, which may be made against them, or any of them, by anyone, which arise out of my actions, including my ordinary negligence, including active and passive, and gross negligence or willful misconduct and/or the active or passive negligence of RELEASED PARTIES while either I or any horse at my request or in my control is/was on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or participating in the COMPETITION.

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I hereby acknowledge and assume the risk that equestrian activity, including jumping, is very dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I expressly acknowledge that injuries may be compounded or increased by negligent maintenance of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES, faulty or improperly secured equipment, improper supervision or compliance with competition rules and regulations, Acts of God and negligent rescue operations or procedures of RELEASED PARTIES and negligent handling of horses and independent operations by trainers, riders and/or boarders who use the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES or others who are not affiliated with RELEASED PARTIES. I acknowledge that horses can be injured while being ridden, groomed, stabled, walked and/or exercised and I expressly assume the risk of injury to any horse under my control and/or custody or on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES at my request.

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California with respect to all RELEASED PARTIES. I agree this Release extends to all acts of ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law. If any portion of this Release and/or Entry Blank is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect. I have not relied on any oral representations or statements made that are contrary to or modify the above Release or warnings. I agree that by signing the front page of this Entry Blank that I am bound by the Release, waiver and warnings contained herein and that both sides/pages constitute one incorporated agreement. If applicable, I agree I have the express authority to sign this entry blank/Release on behalf of the owner and/or rider.

I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Show Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Show Ground Facility. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of California, and any action instituted must be filed in California.
