

2025 Gold Coast Horse Show Series Trainer Trips sponsored by LEGIS Equine



Our parent company, The Langer Group has a long history of sending trainers on vacation. Since 2004 trainers at LEG's various shows have won trips to luxury vacation resorts in Hawaii, Lake Tahoe, Colorado Springs, Palm Desert, Newport Beach, and more. This year it could be you!

Gold Coast is continuing the legacy and awarding trips to three different categories of hunter/jumper trainers. The 2025 series begins at the 2024 Gold Coast Finale and concludes at the 2025 Gold Coast October show. Winners will be announced at the Gold Coast Gala.

The following Gold Coast Series Trainer Trips will be awarded at the conclusion of the 2025 season:

- Leading Jumper Trainer
- Leading Hunter/Equitation Trainer Category A (classes where jumps do not exceed 2'3")
- Leading Hunter/Equitation Trainer Category B (Classes with jumps 2'6" 3'6")

Points are awarded based on the placing of horses in designated classes or from a section's championship chart as follows: 7-5-4-3-2-1. In case of a tie at the end of the season, the tie will be broken as follows in the following order:

- The trainer who attended the most shows.
- If still tied, the trainer with the most points in the special classes (derbies and/or jumper)
- If still tied, both trainers will receive a trip.

Trainers must be listed as the trainer of record on a horse's entry in order for that horse (or rider) to contribute points toward a trainer's point totals. In case of a dispute, the Show Manager and the Show Secretary will meet and confer, along with either a USEF judge or steward, and their decision will be final. A trainer can only win one trip per season. Should a trainer win more than one trip category, the trainer will be given the trip for the category the trainer has earned the most points in. The next highest placed trainer in the other category will be awarded the trainer trip for that category. Our intention is to award three trips to three different trainers.

Each of the trainer trip categories will be calculated as detailed below:

<u>Leading Jumper Train</u>er

Trainers will earn points based on their highest ranked horse on the championship charts for all classes that award a show championship, as well as the highest placed horse in the \$1,000 (or greater) special jumper class.

Leading Hunter/Equitation Trainer Category A

Trainers will earn points based on their highest ranked horse or rider on the championship charts for all sections restricted to juniors and amateurs held at 2'3" and below, as well as the highest placed horse in the LEG Up Derby.

Leading Hunter/Equitation Trainer Category B

Trainers will earn points based on their highest ranked horse or rider on the championship charts for all sections restricted to juniors and amateurs held at 2'6" and higher, as well as the highest placed horse in the Carousel Derby, 2'6" Hunter Derby, 3'0" Hunter Derby, and the 3'0" Child/Adult Hunter Derby.

Points will be posted on the Gold Coast website. Any discrepancy must be reported via email (show@goldcoasthorseshows.com) by October 30, 2025. The discrepancy must list the details of the discrepancy.

Winners will be announced at the Gold Coast Gala and presented with their trip certificates. Winners will have twelve months to take their trip. Trips may be transferred at the winner's request.
