Entries

Entries are submitted electronically via Ring Radar (ringradar.com). Closing date for each show is seven days before the first day of competition. Late entries will be accepted; entries may be limited on a first-come, first-served basis.

Stabling

Stall reservations are due with entries. Ring Radar automatically assigns a stall to each entry (you are not charged in advance). At check-in, let the office staff know if you do not need a stall and are trailering daily or are an HDHP boarder. All horses pay one of the following: Stall Fee, Trailer-In / Grounds Fee, or an HDHP Boarder Fee.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

ENTRY CLOSING: Entries may be submitted electronically via Ring Radar (ringradar.com). Closing date for each show is seven days before the first day of competition. Late entries will be accepted. Entries may be limited on a first-come, first-served basis.

STALL RESERVATIONS: Due with entries. Ring Radar will automatically assign a stall to each entry; you will not be charged in advance. At check-in, please let the office staff know if you do not need a stall and are trailering daily or are an HDHP boarder. All horses will pay one of the following: Stall Fee, Trailer/Grounds Fee, or an HDHP Boarder Fee.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- a) Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-received basis. Should a show sell out, a waiting list will be established.
 - b) Registration Fee — all horses, showing or non-showing, are assessed the Registration Fee. See Show Fees for the complete list of fees.
 - c) Payment of fees may be made by check, cash, or credit card. Credit cards are charged a 3.5% handling fee.
 - d) Late Entries — entries are due seven days before the first competition day. Entries received after this date are charged the late fee specified on the Show Fees page.
1. **Arrival & Departure.** Horse arrival is any time after 8:00 a.m. on Thursday. Departure is any time before 8:00 p.m. on Sunday. Early arrivals and/or late departures must be arranged in advance by emailing show@goldcoasthorseshow.com. Trainers may set up stalls and tack rooms on Wednesday after 12:00 p.m., provided the trainer notifies the show via the email above.
 2. **Stabling.** Stalls may not be shared or resold. First bedding is not included. Stall fees are refundable if you notify the horse show office before the show begins. The show office handles all stall transactions and charges; private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Stalls are wood (10'x10') and canvas (9'6"x9'6" and 12'x9'6") with canvas roofs; all have doors and dirt floors. Removed stall doors are charged at \$150 per door to the assigned party.
 3. **Grounds Fee.** Charged to entries that do not have a stall and do not officially board at HDHP. This fee includes non-showing day(s) and is specified in the price list. Horses boarded at HDHP pay a separate fee. To be considered an HDHP boarder, HDHP must have a boarding agreement on file.
 4. **Non-Showing Horses.** Any horse on the show grounds but not competing must be registered as a Non-Showing Horse, including a completed and signed entry blank and the requisite fees: registration fee, boarder fee, a stall or grounds fee (as appropriate), and the drug fee. Boarded horses at HDHP not entered but wishing to ride and school in the show area are treated as non-showing horses. All non-showing horses are assigned a number. Late fees apply.
 5. **Feed and Bedding.** Available for purchase during the show. For delivery on arrival, complete the Pre-Show Feed and Bedding order form at goldcoasthorseshow.com by 10:00 a.m. Tuesday of show week. Same-day orders are not available and there are no Sunday deliveries. During the show, orders must be placed by noon for next-day delivery. Exhibitors may bring their own feed/shavings; deliveries from outside feed companies are not allowed.
 6. **Unpaid Accounts.** All accounts not settled by 5:00 p.m. on the last day of competition will be closed by the show secretary using the payment information provided. Entries with no method of payment are charged a \$25 billing fee.
 7. **Numbers.** Horse entry numbers are not released without a form of payment, proper signatures, and all necessary paperwork. All horses on the grounds are assigned a number, including non-showing horses. Whenever horses are lunged or ridden, they must display their number.
 8. **Returned or Declined Payments.** Per USEF Rule GR901.11, all returned checks and declined credit cards are charged a 10% penalty (\$50 minimum). Account holders have ten (10) days to pay in full with cash, cash equivalent, or credit card. After 10 days without payment, the show will notify USEF and other sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.
 9. **Minor Exhibitors.** No minor's entry is accepted unless the entry blank is signed by a parent or guardian.
 10. **Special Classes.** Specifications are listed under Special Classes. Classes with prize money must have at least five entries; otherwise the class is held without prize money or with reduced prize money, and the entry fee lowered.
 11. **Adding Classes.** No additional (post-entry) fee to add regular classes as long as the add is done at the show office before the class starts. Adds must be done by 4:00 p.m. the day preceding the

class to guarantee entry. Same-day adds may be restricted. Adds into special classes after the order is drawn will go first.

- 12. Scratching Classes.** Classes scratched before the start of the class receive full credit, provided the scratch is made in the show office. Gate scratches are not official scratches.
- 13. Show Scratch.** A "Show Scratch" applies to any entered horse that does not show in any class and is not registered as a Non-Showing Horse. For a full refund, Show Scratches must be made before the horse's first class; notify the office staff directly and complete paperwork. Scratches prior to check-in day may be submitted via email. Improper notice results in a \$50 Scratch Fee.
- 14. Substitutions.** Under the same ownership (or lease), a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse as long as the scratched horse has not shown in any class. The scratched horse's registration and stall fees transfer to the substitute with no penalty.
- 15. Conflicts.** Management intends to avoid holding rings for horses/riders. Trainers and riders anticipating a conflict must contact the starters of the affected arena(s) and the show manager. Riders and trainers are responsible for minimizing conflicts. Starters may scratch riders who are not timely. Trainer availability is not a legitimate conflict.
- 16. RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter).** Entries that show in a class without being properly entered are charged the class entry fee plus a \$25.00 RDNE fee per class.
- 17. Schooling & Paid Warm-Ups.** Schooling is permitted in designated areas only (riding, driving, lunging, leading, exercising). Poling and/or offsets are not permitted anywhere at HDHP. Violations may result in fines and/or elimination. Horses must display their official number and riders must be properly attired. Paid Warm-Up sessions are on the schedule; exceeding the time limit or not exiting when asked may result in doubled fees.
- 18. Protective Headgear & Safety Vests.** Riders are encouraged to wear ASTM/SEI headgear and will not be penalized for doing so. Any exhibitor may wear a protective vest (body-protecting or inflatable) designed for equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge.
- 19. Motorized Vehicles / Golf Carts.** Drive only in designated areas, at safe speeds, with an eye toward safety. Minors without a valid driver's license may not operate motorized vehicles (including golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles) on competition grounds; minors with a valid temporary license must be accompanied by a licensed adult. The parent/guardian who signs the entry blank is responsible for any damages resulting from a minor's operation in violation of this rule. Unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices (segways, hoverboards, single-wheeled scooters) is prohibited. Wheelchairs and mobility-assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt.
- 20. Dogs.** All dogs must be leashed or contained. Owners of loose dogs are subject to a minimum \$100 fine and a USEF Official Warning Card. HDHP is a City of Los Angeles park and its rules also apply.
- 21. Designated Parking.** All horse-show drivers except HDHP boarders and trainers must enter through the Horse Show Entrance Gate (past the HDHP Main Gate). Park in designated areas only; improperly parked vehicles are subject to tow at the owner's expense. Parking in the stable area is not allowed except for immediate loading/unloading. Vehicles with a state-issued disability permit may park in designated spaces.
- 22. Medical Waste.** Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles. Violations are subject to a \$100 fine per occurrence.
- 23. Vaccinations & Health Certificates.** Horses more than seven months of age must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to the show dates; non-compliant horses may be required to leave. A Declaration of Health or Veterinary Health Certificate may be required — check with management for details.
- 24. RV Parking.** A limited number of RV spaces with water and electric are available. Complete and submit the official RV reservation form at goldcoasthorseshow.com. Spaces are first-reserved. High-amp RVs may have restricted electric use. Pump-out service is extra and must be scheduled through the show office with 24-hour notice.
- 25. Cruelty and Abuse.** Cruelty and abuse will not be tolerated at any time, anywhere at Hansen Dam Horse Park.
- 26. Management.** Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding the show without claims for damages or recourse. Management may limit entries, alter courses, cancel/combine/reschedule classes, change rings, substitute judges, change

specifications, etc. All questions not covered in these rules are decided by Management, whose decision is final.

- 27. Alcoholic Beverages & Smoking.** Per City of Los Angeles regulations, alcoholic beverages and smoking (including vaping) are not permitted.
- 28. Cooking & Barbecues.** For fire safety, no cooking or barbecues are allowed at HDHP except in the RV area or another location approved by show management. Only gas or propane barbecues are allowed — no charcoal fires.

Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification for Gold Coast Horse Shows

In consideration for entry upon the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES of the COMPETITION, the undersigned on behalf of myself, my trainers, instructors, coaches, clients, agents, employees, grooms, invitees (including but not limited to anyone I invite to come onto SHOW GROUND FACILITIES), representatives, assigns, executors, heirs, independent contractors (including but not limited to veterinarians, farriers, masseuse, chiropractor, therapists, braiders, shippers), and, if applicable, on behalf of my minor child or children (hereinafter collectively referred to as "I") agrees:

I agree that COMPETITION as used in this entry blank, in the prize list and in the USEF rules means GOLD COAST HORSE SHOWS, each and every class and/or event conducted and ALL ACTIVITIES that I undertake AT ANY TIME and for any purpose upon entry of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES including any horse which is on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for my use, in my control or at my request. I further agree that COMPETITION includes the entire week of the horse show including the time horses and/or people are allowed to enter to set up, stable and/or conduct business whether its expressly and/or specifically related to the horse show and classes being conducted/held that week through and including the time all horses and/or people vacate the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES.

I agree that this Release of Liability includes any horse that I have asked to come onto the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for any purpose, and/or is in my control and/or custody and regardless of whether the horse is being stabled at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or competing in the COMPETITION.

I agree that "RELEASED PARTIES" means the "Competition" known as Gold Coast Horse Show, the "Horse Show Management" and/or "Competition Management" as referenced in the prize list, the Federation Licensee, Hansen Dam Equestrian Center, LLC, LEG Shows & Events, LLC, Langer Equestrian Group Inc., Marnye Langer and each of their officers, directors, managers, members, owners, shareholders, employees, representatives, agents, subsidiaries, volunteers, officials, affiliated and associated persons, companies and organizations, assigns and entities or organizations as may now or hereafter be constituted, that own, are related to or manage the property owned by such entities (whether specifically identified here by name).

I agree that SHOW GROUND FACILITIES means the Hansen Dam Horse Park, including but not limited to all improvements, structures (permanent or temporary), buildings, tents, stalls, fixtures (including but not limited to all jumps and related equipment), arenas (and the footing therein) located on the premises and/or provided by RELEASED PARTIES during the COMPETITION.

I agree that if I am not a member of the Federation that I will abide by all rules and regulations of the Federation. I agree that the Rules of the Prize List are incorporated as if set forth herein.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS: I hereby fully and forever release, waive and discharge the RELEASED PARTIES and each of them who are or might be liable in any way from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of actions, liabilities of any kind which I may or might have against RELEASED PARTIES or any of them, arising from or by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, damage to property, injury to horse and any consequences thereof, which I may sustain due to the ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES; I further agree that except for the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the RELEASED PARTIES, I SHALL NOT SUE or bring any legal action, claim, and/or demand against for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage and/or injury to any horse in relation to the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or the operation and conduct of the COMPETITION. I agree this RELEASE INCLUDES ALL ACTIVITIES I PARTICIPATE IN AND ALL AREAS OF THE SHOW GROUND FACILITIES as defined above. This release also includes all activities I conduct at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and includes all times that I am at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES no matter what the purpose and/or activity being undertaken.

HOLD HARMLESS: I hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless RELEASED PARTIES from and against any and all claims, liabilities, loss, damages, demands, actions, causes of action, including attorneys' fees, cost and expenses of any kind, which may be made against them, or any of them, which arise out of the active or passive negligence of RELEASED PARTIES while either I or any horse at my request or in my control is/was on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or participating in the COMPETITION. I agree to defend RELEASED PARTIES, at my expense, regardless if RELEASED PARTIES are negligent or not. I agree this means that **I will immediately defend, indemnify and hold harmless RELEASED PARTIES if anyone affiliated with me in any respect sues any of the RELEASED PARTIES.**

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I hereby acknowledge and assume the risk that equestrian activity, including jumping, is very dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I expressly acknowledge that injuries may be compounded or increased by negligent maintenance of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES, faulty or improperly secured equipment, improper supervision or compliance with Federation rules and regulations, Acts of God and negligent rescue operations or procedures of RELEASED PARTIES and negligent handling of horses and independent operations by trainers, riders and/or boarders who use the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES or others who are not affiliated with RELEASED PARTIES. I acknowledge that horses can be injured while being ridden, groomed, stabled, walked and/or exercised and I expressly assume the risk of injury to any horse under my control and/or custody or on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES at my request.

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California with respect to all RELEASED PARTIES, except for the Federation as set forth in the Entry Blank. I agree this Release extends to all acts of ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law. If any portion of this Release and/or Entry Blank is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect. I have not relied on any oral representations or statements made that are contrary to or modify the above Release or warnings. I agree that by signing this document that I am bound by the Release, waiver and warnings contained herein. I agree I have the express authority to sign this entry blank/Release on behalf of the owner and/or rider.
